Study Folder for Real Science-4-Kids Biology I

We've completed the first section of the study folder. There are ten sections, one for each chapter. The study folder is really two folders. Each folder has six sides. You use five sides, and you have one side left over for whatever you want. What we're going to do is leave the outside (bright yellow) center panel blank on both folders. When we're done, we'll paste them together and we'll have a four flap lap book.

These photos show how we're laying it out.



I began with a regular file folder. I opened it and folded it into three. Now you have six sections.



After we filled in the printouts for chapter 1, we cut and pasted them to one section.



When it's folded closed, it looks like this.



There are little books and flip-ups like this throughout the entire folder.
